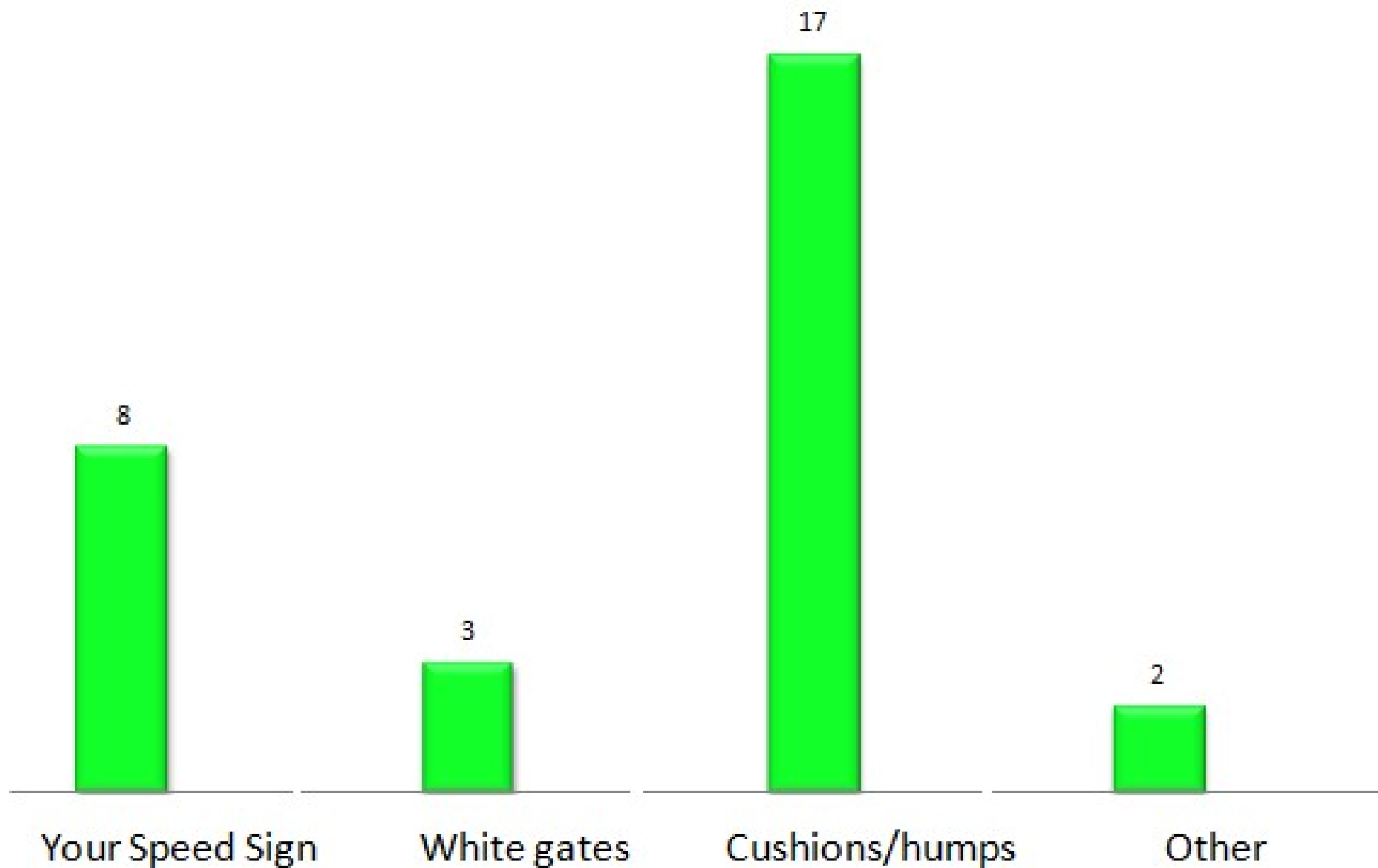

Responses

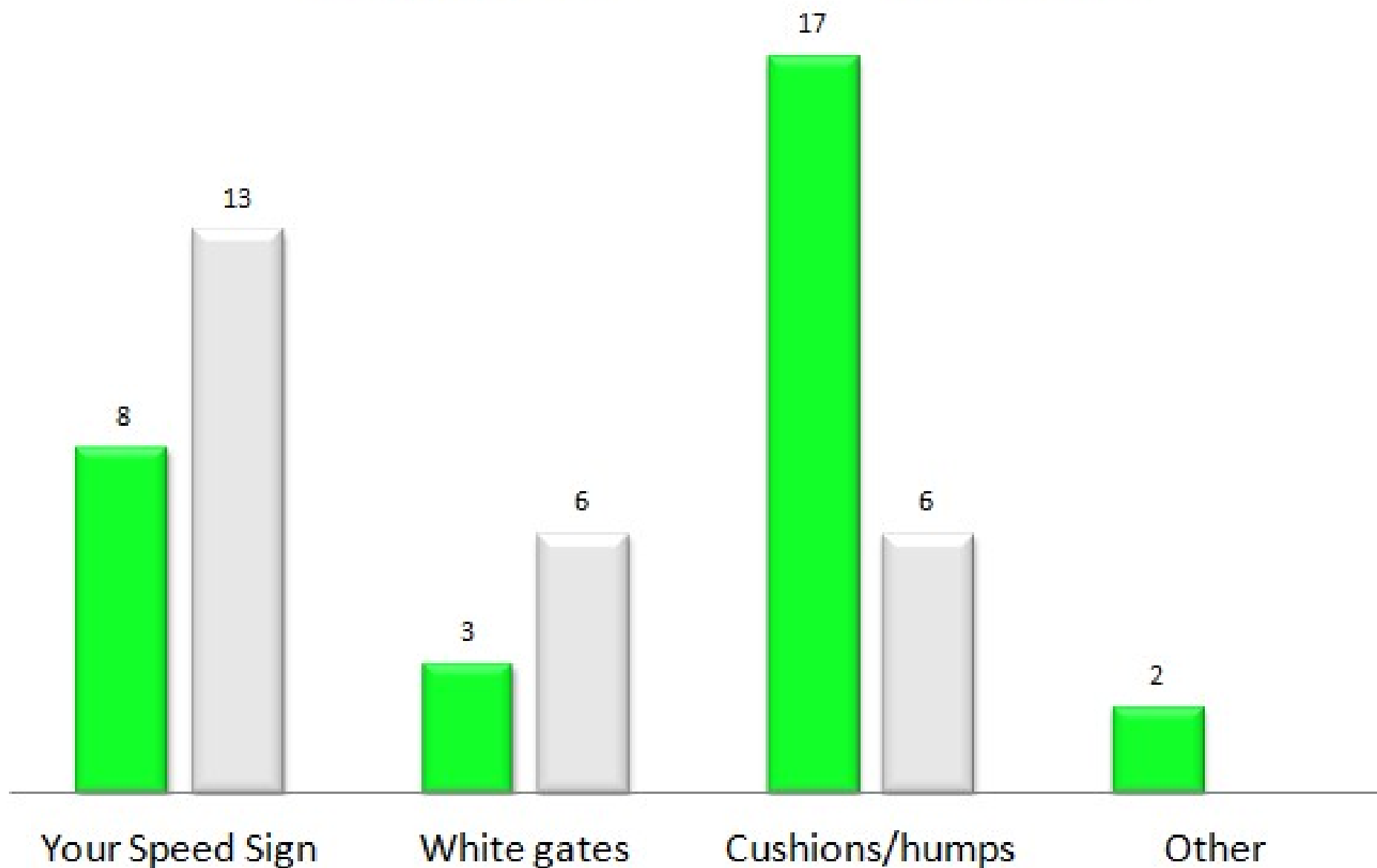
- 95 households received survey.

■ First choice

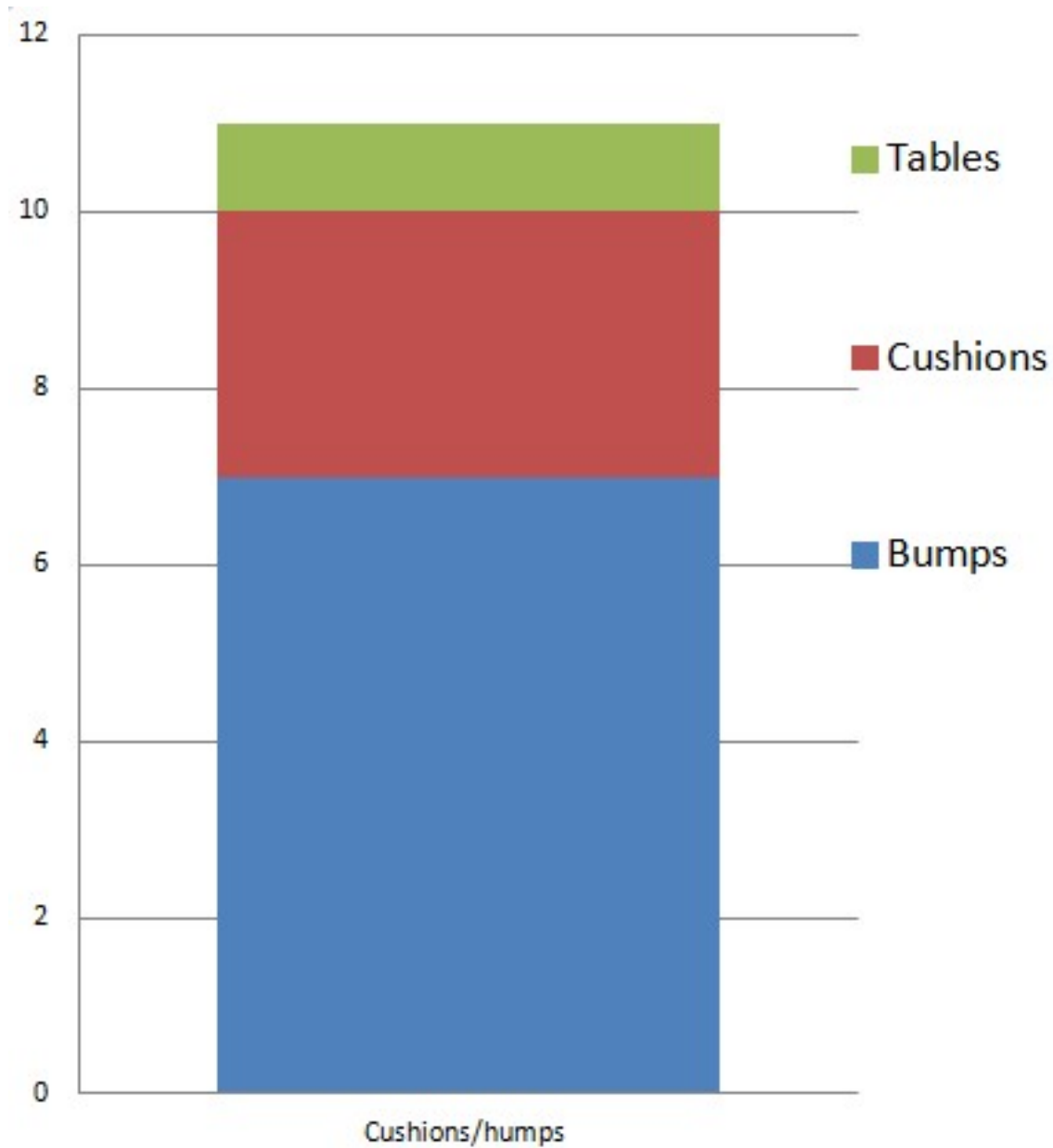

Humps vs Cushions vs Tables





Opposition to Bumps, Cushions, Tables

- Too **expensive**. Creates more road **noise**.
People will still speed between humps.
- A **hazard for cyclists** and increased noise as commercial and farm vehicles cross them.
- Very **expensive**, long winded and intrusive.
- Speed bumps would cause to much **noise**.
- Cannot think that residents want cushions etc outside their gates **NIMBY**.

Other ideas....

- Traffic Priority Chicane e.g. Hampton on the Hill.
- A more frequent police speed trap would be useful.
- Speed camera (x2)
- Speed activated traffic lights.
- Speed cameras, like Hockley Heath.
